NOTES ABOUT CLASSES

- All classes will be pinned according to the Danish system. All entrants will receive a ribbon and the standard first through sixth place. The rider receiving the highest placing will be awarded a prize as well.
- High Point Rider Awards will be based on one-horse one-rider combinations. (1st=6, 2nd=5, 3rd=4, 4th=3, 5th=2, and 6th=1.)
- Note that Junior & Senior riders are expected to be capable of walking, trotting/ jogging, and cantering/ loping their mounts.
- Trail classes will consist only of obstacle work; there will be no rail work. Trail class will be held outside of the show ring.

RULES and REGULATIONS

1. All classes will be run in accordance with the New York State 4-H Horse Show Rule Book; these are available at your County's Cooperative Extension Office.
2. All entrants in all divisions must wear SEI-ASTM approved safety helmets in ALL classes and whenever mounted. NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. All riders must wear appropriate equine suitable footwear with heel.
4. Riders must ride their own project horses. No trading horses for games, jumping, etc.
5. All horses/ponies/mules must have proof of a 2006/2007 negative Coggins and a 2007 rabies vaccination (original documents required at all shows). NO EXCEPTIONS
6. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class(s).
7. The Show Committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
8. Out of county, send a copy of your 4-H riding evaluation form and 4-H horse certificate with your entry. (In county, should be on file with CCE Office).
9. Judges and/or Show Committee's decisions are final and entries may be disqualified or asked to leave for failing to follow the rules or instructions.
10. Refunds will be made only if a doctor's or veterinarian's certificate is presented.
11. Riders will be excused from any class in which the judge/Horse show staff deems there has been coaching from the ringside.
12. Classes with less than three entries may be cancelled or combined.
13. Schooling will be allowed in the ring between 8 and 9AM only; limited space outside of the ring will be available at other times.
14. Red ribbons must be displayed in the tails of all horses that may kick or have potential to kick at every show. NO EXCEPTIONS
15. All dogs must be restrained, kept quiet and away from the ring. Also, parents and children must remain at least one foot away from the fence at all times. **Any verbal aid offered to riders when competing in the show ring will result in disqualification. NO EXCEPTIONS**
16. Manure, hay and, garbage must be cleaned up from all areas before leaving the show grounds.
17. Pre-enter by **July 27** to receive discounted rates. Entrants may add classes for \$5 each on the day of the show, or delete classes with no refund on the day of the show day.

- Exhibitors must have proof of riding level through 4-H Evaluation Program.
