Part 1:

On this part you have three choices. You must complete two out of the three choices. We will arrange the time & place (where applicable) that they are to be done.

- 1) Present the “Horse Book In A Bucket” program to a group of cloverbuds, kindergartners, first or second graders. The office has all the materials you will need for this presentation.
- 2) Participate in a teen leader activity. This can be set up through the office or your club as a teen leader or teen helper activity.
- 3) Must complete some type of community service. It must be pre-approved by the office/Star Test organizer or you will not receive credit for it. Also the office/Star Test organizer must have on file a note or letter from the place or organization that you are doing the community service for stating what you did.

Part 2:

Must complete and hand in completed project horse books to the office or Star Test organizer. These are available at the 4H office.

Part 3:

In this part you must participate in the planning, set-up, tear down of a horse related display at Fair or Old MacDonald’s Farm. This may include making posters, or collecting data and maybe a few small hands on projects. The work required will vary depending on what the display topic is and how many people are taking Test 5.

Part 4:

This is the last part. You must now write a 500 word essay on what 4H means to you. The essay must include why you would or would not recommend 4H to other people.
