- **Open to all youth and adults- all MUST wear an approved helmet when mounted on a horse**
- **Jr. Horses must be handled and ridden by an adult ONLY if the horse is under the age of 3 years.**
- **Required proof of 2010 or 2011 negative Coggins test and Rabies certificate (within year for NY residents)**
- **Pre-entries accepted until May 6<sup>th</sup> for May 14<sup>th</sup>, May 30<sup>th</sup> for June 4<sup>th</sup>, June 13<sup>th</sup> for June 19<sup>th</sup> at \$5.00 per class**
- **Entries received after the above dates or on the day of each show will be charged \$5.00 extra**
- **Horse Council Fee is \$5.00 per horse/per weekend**
- **Non-Member Registration fee is \$5.00**
- **MUST sign acknowledgement of risk form from Cornell Cooperative Extension insurance company (available at the show)**

### **General Guidelines for the Show:**

- Anyone mounted on an equine during a Cornell Cooperative Extension or Chemung County 4-H sponsored event must wear a helmet at all times regardless of age.
- Horses are not to be free lunged or turned loose in any of the pens at any time.
- Any participant, leader, co-leader, parent must have a current PW Wood release from on file for each current calendar year. Non-members must fill one out at each event.
- Horse Show committee reserves the right to dismiss any animal or exhibitor that is unfit to show. This could be a result of malnourishment, cruelty or unsportsmanlike conduct during an event.

### **Level Guidelines:**

- **Level 1** = Leadline (at least 5 years old or in Kindergarten, lead by an adult/older kid)
- **Cloverbud/Beginner Level 2** = 5-8 year olds or just starting to W/T - walk/jog/trot/back
- **Level 2** = Walk /Jog/Trot/Back- 9 years old and over (does not need to know diagonals)
- **Level 3** = Walk/Jog/Trot/Lope/Canter/Back (does not need to know leads, must know diagonals)
- **13& Under** = Walk/Jog/Trot/Lope/Canter/Back (must know leads and diagonals)
- **14 - 19** = Walk/Jog/Trot/Lope/Canter/Back (must know leads and diagonals)
- **Adult Division** = Anyone over 19 years of age (must know leads and diagonals)
