We would like for this to be an interactive event so please plan on staffing your booth as much as possible. The public and your business will both benefit from your personal touch.

- o **Registration** is \$30 for a 10x10 space. (submitted with Vendor Registration)
- o **Electricity** is available. Please let us know ASAP if you need power.
- o Vendors will need to provide their **own table and chairs.**
- o We have applied to NYS Ag and Markets to make this an **Official Farmers' Market** so that we can accept Farmers' Market Checks. We are currently pending their approval.
- o **Set up** can begin at 8:00am.
- o **Parking** will be available curbside in some cases. Parking for larger vehicles will be available in the Community Bank parking lot at the corner of Columbia and Gray Street. Please try to stay toward that corner, as the bank will be open on Saturday.
