4-H CHAMPION AWARDS

4-H JUNIOR CHAMPION: Open to all 4-H Youth age 9-12 years. Winners receive a 70% scholarship to attend 4-H Camp for 1 week during the next summer. **Up to (6) Youth will be selected based on their accomplishments, both current and cumulative.**

4-H SENIOR CHAMPION: Open to all 4-H Youth, age 13 to 18. Winners receive a 70% scholarship to "4-H Career Explorations" held at Cornell University. Participants take part in either Focus For Teens or University U, while staying in dorms at Cornell University. **Up to (6) Youth will be selected based on their accomplishments, both current and cumulative.**

TROPHY & PLAQUE AWARDS

JULIE K. BLANCHARD JR. ACHIEVEMENT AWARD: Sponsored by the Chenango County 4-H Teen Council, this award is given to (1) 4-H Youth under the age of 13. Recipient is determined by high score on Jr. Champion Award Score Sheet. Past recipients are not eligible.

ACHIEVEMENT PLAQUE: For Outstanding Project Work and Overall Accomplishments throughout one's 4-H Career. Awarded to up to (2) 4-H Teens annually.

LEADERSHIP PLAQUE: For Outstanding Project Work & Overall Accomplishments and demonstration of Leadership Qualities and Abilities throughout one's 4-H career. Awarded to up to (2) 4-H Teens annually.

TEEN AWARD TRIPS

AGRI-BUSINESS CAREER (ABC) CONFERENCE: open to youth age 14 & over who wish to become more aware of the opportunities in agriculture and also the requirements for employment in various agri-businesses. The trip features tours to agricultural businesses in the Cobleskill area, as well as seminars and guided tours of the SUNY Cobleskill campus and agricultural facilities. **Up to (4) Youth may be selected based on their agricultural accomplishments and interests to represent Chenango County. Total expenses will be paid for by the Chenango County 4-H Program.**

October 20-21, 2005.

CAPITOL DAYS: Trip is to our state capitol, Albany, where participants have the opportunity to observe our state government process, meet their local legislators and tour the government complex. **(2) 4-H Youth may be selected. Total expenses will be paid for by the Chenango County 4-H Program.**

March 7-8, 2005

MULTI-COUNTY/HONOR AWARD TRIP: 4 days and 3 nights in the Big Apple - New York City. Join teens from several New York State counties on this unique cultural experience. Highlights of past trips have included Broadway style shows, Radio City Music Hall Christmas Spectacular, Statue of Liberty, Lincoln Center, taxi and subway rides, United Nations, Rockefeller Center, Wall Street and more! Trip is most appropriate for mature and open-minded teens. **(2) 4-H Youth may be selected per year. Expenses are partially paid by County 4-H Program.**

December 6-9, 2004

CAREER EXPLORATION TRIP: Held in May on even numbered years, awarded bi-annually on odd numbered years. This 3-day, 2-night trip focuses on different career options in the home economics field. Trip will go to the Vermont and New England area. Past tours have included the King Arthur Flour Plant, Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream, and The Culinary Institute. **(2) 4-H Youth may be selected. Trip is totally funded by Chenango County 4-H Program.**
