

Superior 4-H Club Contest

Superior Club Contest is a club competition, (voluntary) to encourage 4-H clubs in Franklin County to participate in a more complete, year-round 4-H Program. All interested clubs with the exception of Cloverbud groups are eligible. The club Organization Leader keeps track throughout the year and then submits a contest report for the eligible competition level.

The categories and prizes are: **Bronze Clover Club** winner receives their choice of single base flag set, Pledge Banner, Motto Banner, or free club registration fee for the upcoming 4-H year. **Silver Clover Club** winner receives a \$15 cash award. **Emerald Clover Club** winner receives \$25 cash award.
