2. All participants are to refrain from romantic displays, sexual activities, and harassment either in public or private situations. These actions will not be tolerated.
3. All participants at 4-H events are expected to observe the specific rules set up for that event, including (but not limited to) curfew times, remaining in assigned rooms, being at the proper place at the proper time, and keeping chaperones informed of health or other problems.
4. All participants will represent Cornell Cooperative Extension of Franklin County's 4-H Program with dignity and pride. Members will be considerate and courteous of all youth and adults and their property during travel, at group gatherings and during free time.
5. All participants are expected to show a good attitude, listen attentively to speakers or tour guides, ask questions when the opportunity arises, be cooperative with a willingness to "give and take" when decisions are being made.
6. All participants will refrain from using profanities.
7. All participants will be respectful of differences in religion, culture, race and customs of the people they come in contact with while attending any 4-H sponsored event.
