- Very Small Equine is defined as an equine measuring 40 inches and under.
- A pony is defined as an equine 14.2 hands and under.
- Draft horses are encouraged to participate, entering the appropriate horse or pony class.
- Wooden wheeled OR wire wheeled vehicles are acceptable.
- All Classes will be judged in accordance with American Driving Association rules unless otherwise specified.
- Cantering is not permitted.
