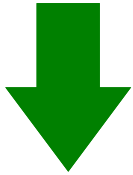

4-H Teen Council is a group of 4-Hers, who under the guidance of adult volunteer advisors, meet monthly to plan and implement the teen exchange, fund raising, and other fun and educational opportunities such as the Teen Press Corps. Through common interest in 4-H, teen council members can gain a better understanding of life in another part of the country. Through their involvement in fund raising and in activities such as the Teen Press Corps, the youth develop leadership and communication skills, build new friendships, and appreciate the spirit of teamwork.

OUR PROGRAMS

TEEN EXCHANGE:

The 4-H Teen Exchange program provides a two-year exchange with another state. Our teens travel first to the host county. Oneida County 4-Hers will host teens during the following year. 4-H families provide housing during our hosting year and the 4-H Teen Council pays for everything (entry fees, bus trips, etc.) that the guests do during the visit. The guest will be responsible for his or her own spending money for souvenirs.

FUND RAISING: In order to participate in the 4-H Teen Exchange, it is required to participate in fund raising. Fund raising opportunities have been November pie sale, hosting at the New York State Farm Show, assist with the New York State Fair Tram ride and others.

TEEN PRESS CORPS: Teen Council members may participate in putting together the Oneida County Fair Newsletter, "Fair Times for Fairgoers". The newsletter is published twice during the fair week and will highlight fair results and upcoming activities/shows. The youth will conduct research and interviews, layout the articles for printing and distribute the final product.

TEEN COUNCIL MEETINGS:

Members are expected to attend all meetings and fundraisers. Teen Council meetings are held at 7:00 PM on the second Thursday of the month at The Cornell Cooperative Extension Office.
