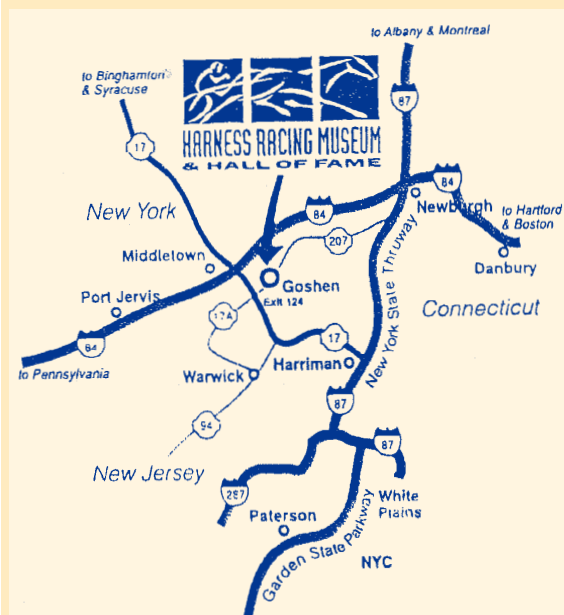
### Harness Racing Museum 240 Main St., Goshen, NY 10924

**From the North:** NYS Thruway (Route 87S) to Route 84W to Exit 4E (Route 17E). Take 17E to Exit 124; bear right onto Route 207; Museum is ¼ mile past second traffic light on the right.

**From the West:** Route 84E to Exit 4E (Route 17E) to Exit 124; bear right onto Route 207. Museum is ¼ mile past the second traffic light on the right.

**From the East:** Route 84W to Exit 4E (Route 17E) to Exit 124; bear right onto Route 207; Museum is ¼ mile past second traffic light on the right.

**From the South:** NYS Thruway (Route 87N) to Exit 16 (Route 17W). Take 17W to Exit 124; left at traffic light. Next light turn right onto Route 207. Museum is ¼ mile past next traffic light on the right.

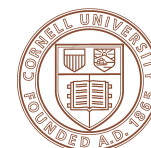
