Go home with 8 bars of soap! (two each of four different types)

The type of soap Grandma made is called "Cold Process"*. It is made by combining fatty acids and sodium hydroxide (lye) together. Fatty acids can be almost any oil - from beef tallow to olive oil to hemp oil. The combinations for making your own personal recipe are endless. Cold process soap making is a combination of an art and science.

- ✓ Hear the history of soap making.
- ✓ Natural soap ingredients and their benefits.
- ✓ Why use natural soap over commercial, store-bought.
- ✓ Make your own soap!
- ✓ Each participant will receive a packet of information that has recipes, handouts, lye cautions, etc.

**Cold process soap making will require the use of lye. You will be provided with the necessary safety equipment, such as long-sleeved lab coats, safety glasses, and nitrile gloves (not latex). Each participant will be required to sign a risk waiver before the start of the session, and will need to bring two old towels and a tray upon which to carry the soap home.*
