### PLANT DONATIONS NEEDED FOR MASTER GARDENER PLANT SALE

Cornell Cooperative Extension of Otsego County will be holding its Annual Master Gardener Plant Sale on May 30, from 10 AM-1 PM. The Master Gardeners are seeking plant donations.

Each year the Annual Plant Sale offers a large selection of perennials, annuals, houseplants, herbs and vegetables at reasonable prices. The large selection of plants comes from the Master Gardener's yards and other local donations. This year some of the perennials will include Feverfew, Jacob's Ladder, Artemisia, Ribbon Grass, Dianthus, Rudbeckia, Shasta Daisy, Bee Balm, Lemon Balm, Heliopsis, Coreopsis, Yellow Primrose, Hosta, Lady's Mantle and White Phlox. An assortment of wildflowers and lilies will be available. Annuals will include Licorice Plant, Verbena, Scabiosa, Begonia and New Guinea Impatiens. Vegetable and herb seedlings will also be available.

In addition to the Plant Sale, Extension staff and volunteers will be offering Brooks' Bar-B-Q from 11 AM to 2 PM.

If you have perennials that need thinning or extra plants in your garden and would like to donate plants to the Master Gardener Plant Sale, they may be dropped off from Monday, May 18th through Friday, May 29th, at the Extension Office, 123 Lake Street, in Cooperstown. Office hours are weekdays, 8:30 AM - 4:30 PM. Funds raised from the Master Gardener Plant Sale will help the Master Gardeners provide environmentally sound information through the Gardener's Helpline, conduct outreach and workshop programs and foster land and community stewardship.
