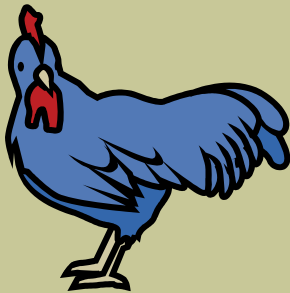

WHY RAISE BROILERS?

Raising your own food allows you to cut down on food miles, ensure that your meat is humanely raised, and monitor what is being fed to the animals that you eat. You can't get more local than your yard and raising broilers is the perfect opportunity for you to generate nitrogen for your garden, fertilize your lawn, or teach your children about where their food comes from. Raising broilers can be the first step towards having a permanent flock at your home.
