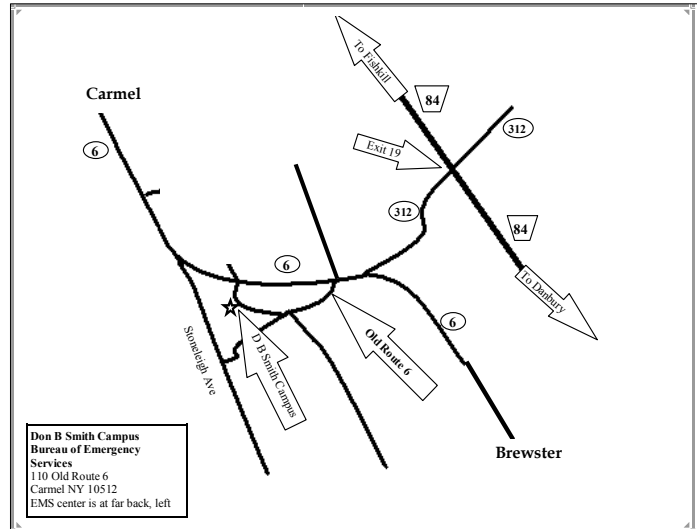
Directions to Putnam County Emergency Training and Operations Center:

From Taconic Parkway: Route I-84 east to exit 19. Turn right, go to Route 6. Turn right. At second light, turn left into Smith Campus. Follow signs to Emergency Training Center.

From Mahopac: Route 6 to Lake Gleneida. Turn right at Reed Library. Go two miles, past Putnam Plaza, to second light. Turn right into Smith Campus.

From Cold Spring: Route 301 to Carmel, Gleneida Ave. Turn right. Turn left at Route 6 light. Go two miles, past Putnam Plaza, to second light. Turn right into Smith Campus.

The Bureau of Emergency Services Training and Operations Center (112 Old Route 6) is located at the far end of the Building 2 & 3 parking lot.
