Dear Prospective Counselor-In-Training,

We would like to offer you an opportunity to participate in our Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Program at Hidden Valley 4-H Camp this summer.

The three main goals of the CIT program are to train potential staff, provide personal growth, and promote leadership development. The Hidden Valley 4-H Camp CIT Program is designed for teens that have completed at least the 10th grade and/or are 15 or 16 years of age and are interested in becoming counselors at Hidden Valley 4-H Camp. This two week-long program (including weekend) concentrates on leadership training, team building, skill development, service to camp, and personal growth. The program will provide a time of transition for each participant as they develop from campers into counselors.

We are looking for youth who display a good attitude toward others, exemplify the four H's (Head, Heart, Hands, and Health), and demonstrate self-respect.

The first CIT session (weeks 2 and 3) runs from July 19-July 31 and the second CIT session (weeks 4 and 5) runs from August 2-14. CIT's pay one fee of \$600 which includes two weeks and the weekend in between.
